Cal Farley's offers community based services through family resource centers located in three Texas urban cities: Amarillo, Dallas-Fort Worth and Houston. #### **Boys Ranch Campus Operations:**

During the fiscal year ended September 30, 2006, Cal Farley's Boys Ranch served 352 boys and girls ranging in ages from 5 to 18 at the Boys Ranch Campus. In May, 2006, 32 residents graduated from Boys Ranch Independent School District who had an average length of stay at Boys Ranch of 3.77 years.

#### Girlstown, U.S.A. Campus Operations:

During the fiscal year ended September 30, 2006, Cal Farley's served 79 girls ranging in ages from 12 to 18 at the Girlstown, U.S.A. campus near Whiteface, Texas. In May, 2006, 9 residents graduated from nearby Whiteface High School who had an average length of stay at Girlstown of 2.38 years.

#### **Admission and Family Liaisons:**

During the year ended September 30, 2006, the Cal Farley's call center answered over 3,717 telephone calls that resulted in information about Cal Farley's programs sent to 2,019 callers and 1,698 referrals to other agencies and resources.

Managers of the three Family Resource Centers carried an average caseload of 14 to 16 families a month assisting them with training and other ways to strengthen their families and relations with children.

Through the Alumni Support Services and Cal Farley's Transitional Living Program, 30 alumni were provided with housing and other living assistance during the year ended September 30, 2006.

### Description

## **GRANTS FOR SCHOLARSHIPS**

Academic and vocational scholarships are provided to alumni of Cal Farley's Boys Ranch upon graduation from high school. The scholarships are determined by a scholarship committee consisting of the campus administrators, President & CEO, a Board of Directors representative, Boys Ranch ISD School Superintendent or their named representative, Community Services Director, Development Support representative, and Alumni Coordinators. All high school graduates are given the opportunity to present their application, in person, to the scholarship committee. Most requests are approved at some level of monetary assistance and scholarship award recommendations are made by the Scholarship Committee and approved by the President. Subsequent scholarships throughout their college careers are dependent upon the recipients' performance (i.e. grade point average, degree of progress, etc.). Recipients' performance and progress is closely monitored by copies of grades furnished by the recipients each semester and on-campus visits by a member of the scholarship committee. 68 scholarships were awarded in fiscal year '05-'06.
